# THE MIDWEST CLUB SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL CLUB MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS ARE SUBJECT TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE MIDWEST CLUB. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL!

The operation of the Midwest Club Swimming Pools is subject to tight regulations and close inspection by the State of Illinois and DuPage County Health Officials. The following rules have been established on the basis of the State and County requirements and policy of the Midwest Club.

## **POOL HOURS:**

10:00 AM. to 8:00 PM.

Pool hours and regulations shall be determined annually by the board of Directors of the Midwest Club and posted. All regulations shall be observed and enforced by the Management.

**Abbreviated Hours:** On weekdays while the area schools are in session during May, June, August and September

The pool will be closed when the temperature falls below 68 degrees. Staff will be on standby to reopen the pool as the weather improves. In the event of thunder, the pool will be closed immediately, and will not reopen for a minimum of 30 minutes after hearing the final sound of thunder.

#### LIFEGUARDS:

- •Chicagoland Pool uniformed guards will be on duty all hours.
- •No one is permitted in or around the pool or deck unless a lifeguard is present.

### DAILY RESIDENT REGISTRATION:

- •The Daily Log Book will be located at the entrance to the Pool Area. All Members and family members must sign-in prior to using the pool.
- •Children under 9 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by a family member or by someone (13 years of age or older) who has been designated to supervise the children on the **Parental Authorization Form.**
- .•Children 9 years of age and older who pass the swim test of 2 lengths of the pool, will be permitted unaccompanied, only with prior written authorization of their parents on file with the Management.

## **GUEST REGISTRATION:**

GUEST ARE ANYONE OTHER THAN: mother, father, son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter in-law, grand children, and grandparents.

- •Members are allowed up to four (4) guests per day. Residents who own multiple properties in the Midwest Club are limited to only four (4) guests per day.
- •Guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times. Each guest name, including children, must be registered in the Daily Log Book.

## WADING POOL/BABIES & TODDLERS:

- Children in the Wading Pool must be accompanied by a family member or authorized person at all times.
- Children in diapers, training pants or those who have not been properly toilet trained are not permitted in the large pool at any time.
- •Diapers should be changed frequently and properly disposed of in the Locker Room waste cans.

SHOWERING REQUIREMENTS: All persons entering the pools are expected to be freshly showered. If anyone leaves the Pool Area and returns, that person must re-shower before entering the pool.

#### ATTIRE:

- •Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool. Cutoff trousers, sweatshirts, etc. are not permitted for use while swimming. No one in swimming attire is permitted in the Upper Level of the Clubhouse.
- •Shoes, slippers or other appropriate foot attire must be worn when walking to or from the Recreation Club Area and in the Clubhouse, except the shower rooms and the immediate Pool Area.
- •Club Members and their guests are permitted to change clothing only in the Locker Rooms. No clothing is to be left in the Locker Rooms, except

when showering. The Midwest Club is not responsible for clothing left in the Locker Rooms.

#### TOYS:

- •Squirt guns, large inflatable devices or toys (rafts, boats, canoes, etc.) will be allowed under the Guards discretion
- •Bicycles, skateboards, scooters or roller blades **are not permitted** on the Patio Area, in the Pool or Snack Bar Area, or in the Tennis Courts **at any time.** Bicycles must be left at the bike rack only. All skateboards, scooters or roller blades must be left outside of the fenced pool area according to Illinois State Law.

**PETS:** Pets are **NOT** allowed in the Pool or Pool Deck Area at any time.

#### TUBE SLIDE RULES:

- •Each person must slide on his or her back, feet first.
- •Only **one person** is allowed on the slide at a time.
- •Persons must leave the splash area immediately after sliding.
- •Stopping inside the tube at any time is prohibited.
- •Climbing on the slide or platform equipment is prohibited.
- •Flotation devices or other equipment, toys, etc. of any kind are prohibited on the slide.

#### RADIOS:

•Members and their guests are permitted to have radios in the Pool Areas, **only with the use of headphones.** 

#### RESTRICTED ACTIVITIES:

- •Smoking, vaping, and E-cigarette are not allowed in the Pool Area, Deck Area, or Clubhouse.
- •Glass beverage containers or similar fragile items are not allowed in the Pool or the Clubhouse Patio Areas.
- Each individual is responsible for placing personal debris in the proper container.

**BEHAVIOR:** Splashing, running, shouting, loud boisterous activity, profane language, or any other unseemly conduct will not be permitted, and may result in restriction from the pool.

Note: All Club Members and their Guests are subject to all rules and Regulations pertaining to The Midwest Club.

1st Offense: Verbal warning along with an explanation of what will happen if the behavior persists.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense

on same day: Restriction from the Clubhouse for one full day of

operation and a letter sent to the Homeowner.

Lifeguards, Security Officers, Management, and Snack Shop personnel should be treated with respect, as they are expected to courteously enforce the rules and regulations of the Midwest Club. Harassment of these persons will result in immediate dismissal from the pool.

The Clubhouse will be locked promptly at closing time. Failure to vacate the Clubhouse at the specified time may result in penalty fees including a charge for Security Guard overtime pay. The parking lot should also be vacated at the times specified. Security overtime charges may be assessed until guests have vacated the parking lot.

#### **TENNIS COURT RULES**

- •Court hours are from 6:00 a.m. until dusk.
- •Bicycles and skateboards are prohibited on the courts. Any activity, other than tennis, is prohibited on the courts.
- •Food and beverages are not allowed on the tennis courts.
- •Etiquette provides: if the courts are in use when you arrive, place your racquet on the rack board.
- •A court should be released in not more than 1 hour of singles play, or 1-1/2 hours of doubles play.
- Please leave the tennis courts neat and clean.

#### ALL PROCEDURES WILL BE ENFORCED.

#### SNACK SHOP & COMMUNITY ROOM RULES

**SNACK SHOP HOURS**: 12:00 PM.-6:00 PM.

During periods of inclement weather, the Snack Shop may close in accordance with the Pool closings.

## SNACK SHOP PURCHASES/AUTHORIZATION FORMS:

- Purchases may only be charged to a resident. Cash purchases are prohibited.
- Purchases will only be allowed and charged to a resident if a current Snack Shop Authorization Form is on file.
- Only those persons listed on the Snack Shop Authorization Form will be allowed to charge purchases.
- Purchase amounts will be limited to the "dollar per day" limit designated on the card.
- Residents will receive one Snack Shop invoice monthly.

## **GENERAL SNACK SHOP RULES**

- The Snack Shop/Pool Deck Dining Area and the Community Room will be open during Snack Shop hours for food consumption, or for the enjoyment of residents, such as board games and card playing.
- All persons entering the Clubhouse Lower Level from the Pool areas should be thoroughly dry to prevent any damage to furniture or flooring from the chlorinated swimming pool water.
- Residents should properly dispose of trash in waste containers after using the Snack Shop dining area or Community Room.
- The Snack Bar will be open at posted times. Food and beverages are not permitted on the immediate swimming pool decks and tennis court areas.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters or roller blades are not permitted on the Snack Shop Patio Area or Clubhouse at any time. Bicycles must be left at the bike rack only. All skateboards, scooters or roller blades must be left outside of the fenced pool area according to Illinois State Law.
- Running, rowdy or rude behavior, to include the use of profane language, or any other unseemly conduct, is prohibited in the Clubhouse and Snack Shop area, and will result in immediate dismissal.
- Access to the Clubhouse Upper Level is strictly prohibited.
- Pets are not allowed in the Clubhouse at any time.

#### POOL/COMMUNITY ROOM PARTIES:

- The Community Room and pool may not be used for resident private parties during Saturday or Sunday daytime hours, as it must be available to all Midwest Club members at those times.
- The Community Room and pool are available for parties of up to 40 persons during daytime hours (8:30 AM – 6:00 PM), Monday through Friday, for a fee of \$100.00. An hourly fee may also be charged for additional lifeguards, room set up and cleaning as needed.
- A reservation must be made at least two weeks in advance with the Midwest Club Management Office (630-655-9002).
- Lifeguards will be hired in advance to accommodate the number of persons. Notice of cancellation must be received 72 hours in advance or the renter will be responsible for this charge.
- Guests are expected to abide by the Midwest Club Pool Rules and Regulations.
